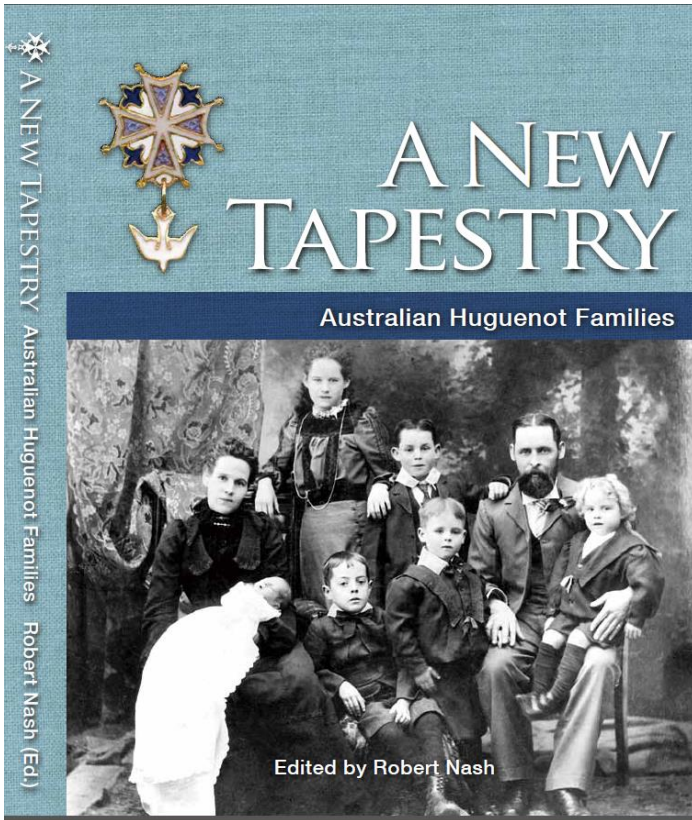


A New Tapestry: Australian Huguenot Families
